The stem is wrapped with damp moss to encourage roots to form. On April 26, Larry Rahme will be giving a class on air layering. Larry is a local grower of Camellias and has supplied the Camellia plants to our Camellia Day for the last several years. Larry will give this air layering class at 601 Seminole Ridge Rd in Melrose at 10 a.m. He will demonstrate this process on plants in the yard. Come out and learn how to do something new.
