November 17th: *The Sun Also Rises* by Ernest Hemmingway

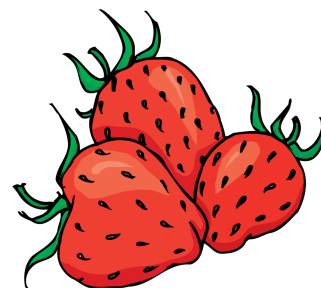
